



**Renewal of Sanctions Regime & Amended United Nations Security Council Sanctions List -
Haiti- October 2024**

No. 12 of 2024

In accordance with the [United Nations Security Council Resolution 2653 \(2022\)](#); the United Nations Security Council Committee renewed the arms embargo, travel ban and assets freeze imposed on Haiti for another year. Also, the United Nations Security Council, acting under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations, unanimously adopted resolution 2752 (2024) and in so doing decided that, with respect to those designated for sanctions, actions that threaten the peace, security or stability of Haiti as set forth in Council resolution 2653 (2022) include “engaging in activities that destabilize Haiti through the illicit exploitation or trade of natural resources”.

Pursuant to this recent pronouncement which was issued on **October 18th, 2024**; Casinos and Gaming House Operators are hereby required to carefully review the notice relative to [Haiti's Renewed Sanctions Regime](#).
