



Public Advisory: United Nations Security Council Renewed Sanctions Regime

Yemen - November 2024

No. 14 of 2024

In accordance with Section 3A of the International Obligations (Economic & Ancillary Measures) (Amendment) Act, 2019; Casinos, Gaming House Operators and the General Public are hereby advised that the United Nations Security Council Committee unanimously adopted resolution 2758 (2024) and decided to renew until 15th November, 2025; the arms embargo, travel ban and assets freeze which were initially imposed by resolution 2140 (2014) on Yemen for another year. The notice concerning [Yemen's Renewed Sanctions Regime](#) was issued on **13th November, 2024**.

Pursuant to this recent update, Casinos and Gaming House Operators are hereby required to carefully review your databases as against Yemen's Amended Sanctions with a view to determining whether any individual listed has been identified as a gaming account holder at your gaming establishment. The findings of your database review shall be reported to the Gaming Board. Provided there are any positive hits during your review, the said hits shall also be reported to the Financial Intelligence Unit and the Office of the Attorney General.
