

## Public Advisory: Amended United Nations Security Council Sanctions List

## ISIL (Da'esh) and Al Qaida- June 2025

No. 03 of 2025

In accordance with Section 3A of the International Obligations (Economic & Ancillary Measures) (Amendment) Act, 2019; Casinos, Gaming House Operators and the General Public are hereby advised that the United Nations Security Council Committee approved the removal of one (1) entry from its List of Individuals and Entities subject to the measures imposed by the United Nations Security Council Resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) concerning ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities. The notice concerning the amended ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List was issued on 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2025.

Pursuant to this recent update, Casinos and Gaming House Operators are hereby required to carefully review your databases as against the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Amended Sanctions listing and thereby make the relevant adjustments to exclude the approved removal from its current database listing.
