



Public Advisory: Amended United Nations Security Council Sanctions List

ISIL (Da'esh) and Al Qaida- March 2026

No. 04 of 2026

In accordance with Section 3A of the International Obligations (Economic & Ancillary Measures) (Amendment) Act, 2019; Casinos, Gaming House Operators and the General Public are hereby advised that the United Nations Security Council Committee approved the addition of two (2) entries to its List of Individuals and Entities subject to the measures imposed by the United Nations Security Council Resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) concerning ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities. The [first notice](#) and [second notice](#) concerning the amended ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List were issued on **March 26th, 2026**.

Pursuant to this recent update, Casinos and Gaming House Operators are hereby required to carefully review your databases as against the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Amended Sanctions listing with a view to determining whether any individual listed has been identified as a gaming account holder at your gaming establishment. The findings of your database review shall be reported to the Gaming Board. Provided there are any positive hits during your review, the said hits shall also be reported to the Financial Intelligence Unit and the Office of the Attorney General.
