



Public Advisory: Amended United Nations Security Council Sanctions List

ISIL (Da'esh) and Al Qaida- May 2026

No. 10 of 2026

In accordance with Section 3A of the International Obligations (Economic & Ancillary Measures) (Amendment) Act, 2019; Casinos, Gaming House Operators and the General Public are hereby advised that the United Nations Security Council Committee approved the removal of seven (7) entries to its List of Individuals and Entities subject to the measures imposed by the United Nations Security Council Resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) concerning ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities. The [ISIL \(Da'esh\) and Al Qaida Amended Sanctions List](#) was issued on **May 21st, 2026**.

Pursuant to these recent updates, Casinos and Gaming House Operators are hereby required to carefully review your databases as against the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al Qaida Amended Sanctions listing and thereby make the relevant adjustments to exclude the approved removals from its current database.
