



Public Advisory: Amended United Nations Security Council Sanctions List

Libya- July 2026

No. 13 of 2026

In accordance with Section 3A of the International Obligations (Economic & Ancillary Measures) (Amendment) Act, 2019; Casinos, Gaming House Operators and the General Public are hereby advised that the United Nations Security Council Committee approved the addition of one (1) entry to its List of Individuals and Entities subject to the measures imposed by the United Nations Security Council Resolutions 1970 (2011), 1973 (2011), 2146 (2014), 2441 (2018), 2509 (2020) and 2819 (2026) concerning Libya associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities. The notice concerning the amended [Libya Sanctions List](#) was issued on **July 23rd, 2026**.

Pursuant to this recent update, Casinos and Gaming House Operators are hereby required to scrutinize your records to determine whether a listed or designated entity holds, owns or controls, directly or indirectly, any funds, financial assets or economic resources or related services, or has any form of relationship with your gaming establishment. The findings of your database review shall be reported to the Gaming Board. Provided there are any positive hits during your review, the said hits shall also be reported to the Financial Intelligence Unit and the Office of the Attorney General.
