



**Public Advisory: Amended United Nations Security Council Sanctions List
Afghanistan – August 2026**

No. 14 of 2026

In accordance with Section 3A of the International Obligations (Economic & Ancillary Measures) (Amendment) Act, 2019, Casinos, Gaming House Operators and the General Public are hereby advised that the United Nations Security Council Committee, established pursuant to Resolution 1988 (2011), approved the amendment of five (5) entries, specified with strikethrough and/or underline, with respect to its 1988 List of Individuals and Entities concerning Afghanistan, who are subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council Resolution 2816 (2026), and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. [Afghanistan's Amended Sanctions List was issued on July 30th, 2026.](#)

Pursuant to the recent amendments, Casinos and Gaming House Operators are hereby required to carefully review your respective databases against Afghanistan's Amended Sanctions List with a view to determining whether any individual listed has been identified as a gaming account holder at your gaming establishment. The findings of your database review shall be reported to the Gaming Board. If any positive hits are identified during your review, such hits shall also be reported to the Financial Intelligence Unit and the Office of the Attorney General.
